Tallinn Airport served 197 thousand passengers in the second quarter

In mid-March, a year passed since the establishment of the COVID-19 emergency situation, which led to a sharp decline in the air traffic volumes across Europe. Compared to the beginning of the year, the second quarter saw a significant recovery in demand. The number of passengers has increased month by month, reaching 98.0 thousand served passengers in June, which is nearly 4 times more compared to a year before; however, 31% of the passengers served in June 2019.

A total of 197,453 passengers were served by Tallinn Airport in the second quarter, which is 411% higher than in the same period last year.

The total number of flight operations at Tallinn Airport in the second quarter was 5,941 (+77%), and 2,471 tonnes of goods and post were carried (+13% compared to last year).

Increased demand has enabled to intensify the flight schedule also on the current routes, incl. to Frankfurt, Helsinki, Riga, Stockholm and Warsaw. As at the end of June, regular flights were open to 25 different destinations, however one-third of all passengers (35%) flew either to the Helsinki or Frankfurt hub. The airlines with the biggest market share in terms of passenger numbers were AirBaltic and Lufthansa, followed by Finnair. Altogether 11 airlines had regular flights from Tallinn. Also, interest in charter flights has increased in proportion to regular flights- the passengers of charter flights made 22% of all passengers. The main destinations were Turkey (Antalya), Egypt and the Canary Islands.

Over the first six months, 283.5 thousand passengers passed the Tallinn Airport, which is 50% less compared to the same period last year.

The total number of flight operations at Tallinn Airport in the first half-year was 9,725 (-19%), and 4,664 tonnes of goods and post were carried (+2% compared to last year).









Results for the second quarter

Covid-19 virus continues to affect the entire aviation and tourism sector. Yet, compared to the same period last year, the restrictions were less stringent and this led to an increase in aviation. The number of passengers and flight operations of Tallinn Airport in the second quarter was better by 411% and 77%, respectively, compared to the same period last year. The number of passengers in regional airports was by 175% higher and there were 61% more flight operations in the second quarter.

The increased number of flight passengers and operations is reflected in the growth of sales revenue. The sales revenue has increased by EUR 2.6 million, i.e., 99%, compared to the second quarter of the previous year.

Due to the low revenue base, the company continued to operate in a cost-saving mode. The costs of the company in the second quarter were the same as the year before - altogether EUR 8.9 million. At the same time, the goods, raw material and services were higher by EUR 0.4 million and staff costs by EUR

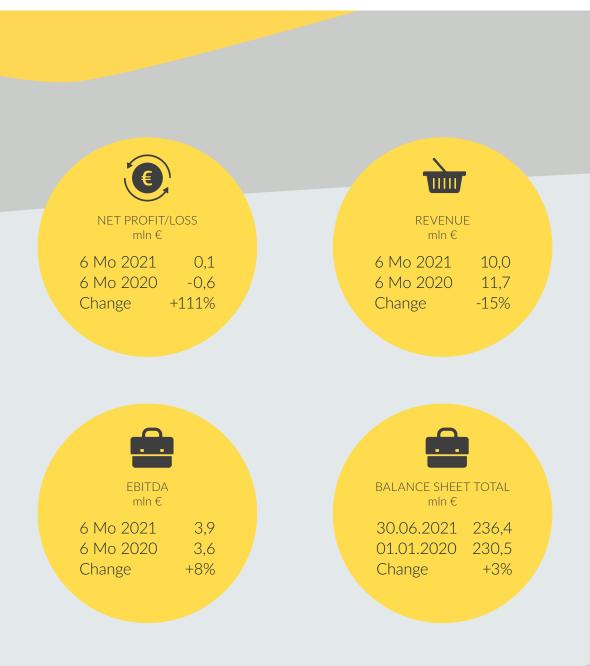


0.3 million. Last year, in the period from April to June, the workload and salary of all employees were reduced by 30%. Depreciation, amortisation and impairment were by EUR 0.4 million lower and other operating expenses by EUR 0.3 million lower.

In the second quarter, the Group's **operating profit before depreciation of non-current assets (EBITDA) was EUR 2.4 million**, i.e., by EUR 1.7 million (+260%) more than a year before.

The **profit of Q2 was EUR 0.45 million**. The result for the same period last year was a loss of EUR 1.5 million.

The Group's cash balance is sufficient to continue the implementation of the investment plan and meet its obligations on time.





Results for the period of January–June

Total income of the Group amounted to EUR 18.1 million, which is by EUR 2.1 million less (-10%) than in the comparable period of last year. The **sales revenue decreased by EUR 1.7 million** (-15%) and other operating income decreased by EUR 0.3 million (-4%). January and February of the last year were the months with normal business, when the virus was not yet influencing the aviation.

Decline in the sales revenue results from the COVID-19 impact, the reason for the decline was a EUR 1.2 million drop in aviation revenue (-31%) and EUR 0.6 million (-7%) in non-aviation revenue.

In aviation revenue, the passenger charges decreased the most, by EUR 0.8 million (-47%). In non-aviation revenue, the concessions and rental income of passenger terminal decreased the most, by EUR 0.6 million (-47%). Revenue from services to passengers and planes increased by EUR 0.3 million (+8%), including the revenue from de-icing increased by EUR 0.4 million (+64%), caused by weather conditions. Due to the lower number of passengers this year,



other non-aviation revenue also decreased.

Other operating income has decreased by EUR 0.3 million. The reason is the government grants related to assets recognised as income, which is by EUR 0.4 million less. Implementation of the support measure from the Estonian Unemployment Insurance Fund provided EUR 1.4 million of funds during the period of April to June, to cover labour costs. Last year, the Group received EUR 2.0 million of salary support.

Total operating expenses of the Group amounted to EUR 18.0 million, which is by EUR 2.8 million less (-13%) than in the same period last year. Labour costs have decreased by EUR 0.9 million (-11%), incl. the number of employees in the Group (FTE, 6 months' average, the reduced workload in April-June of the last year has been excluded) decreased -24% compared to the same period last year. Due to the significant decline in operating volumes, the useful life of non-current assets has been changed due to the correlation between the intensity of use and useful life and accordingly, the depreciation costs of non-current assets have decreased by EUR -0.8 million, i.e., -13%.

In the first six months, the Group's operating profit before depreciation of non-current assets (EBITDA) was EUR 3.9 million, i.e., by EUR 0.3 million (+8%) more than a year before.

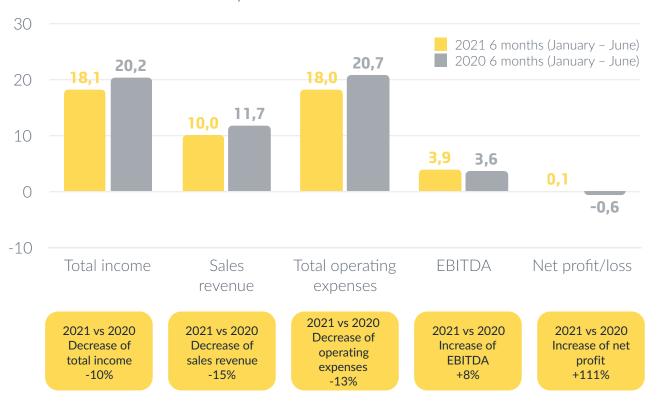
The **net profit** of AS Tallinna Lennujaam (hereinafter the Group) **during the period from January to June was EUR 0.1 million**, being an increase of EUR 0.7 million, i.e., +111%, compared to the year before. The Group's result for the six months of the last year was a loss of EUR 0.6 million.

Group's operating cash flows for six months made EUR 2.3 million. The Group paid EUR 11.7 million for investments in non-current assets and received EUR 3.7 million in government grants for the acquisition of non-current assets. The total amount of loans repaid by the Group was EUR 1.6 million.

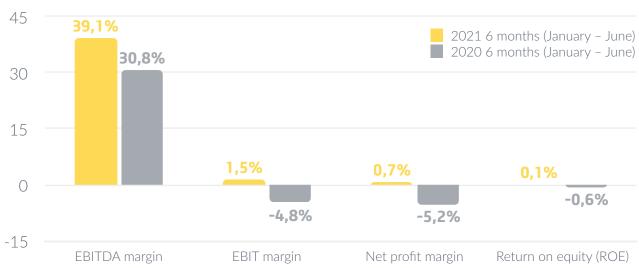
Total assets of AS Tallinna Lennujaam Group as at the end of June amounted to EUR 236.4 million, having increased by EUR 5.8 million (+3.0%) compared to the beginning of the year. Equity was EUR 94.0 million, which is by EUR 0.1 million more compared to the start of the year.
